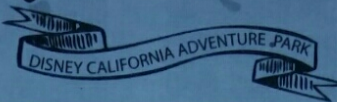
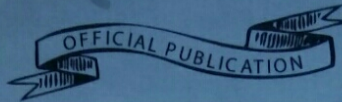

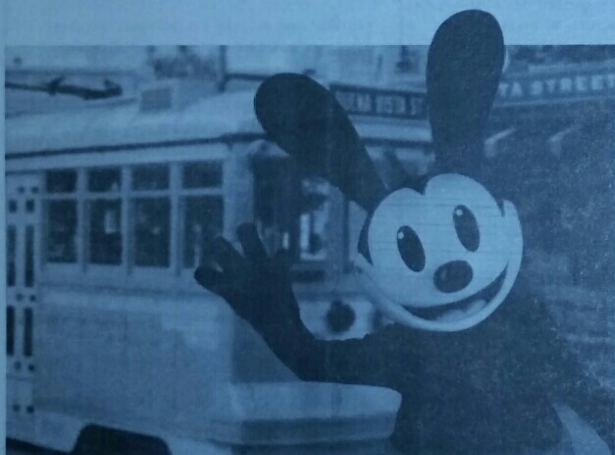

"I" on Food, with Inglebert Irving Alfresco Tasting Terrace

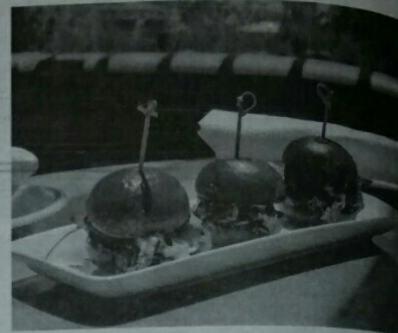
Wine has always been a specialty of mine. So many complexities. So many nuances. It requires a truly refined palate to even begin to comprehend it. So, upon hearing the Golden Vine Winery was debuting the Alfresco Tasting Terrace on its, visually stunning, second floor, my olfactory inclinations grew ripe with condescension.

Arriving on the open-air veranda to a magnificent, autumn California sunset, I chose a seat in the corner of the intimate setting to let my ire percolate. Surprised to learn the menu had changed to showcase a series of small plates intended for sharing, I ordered the Aged Cheddar Risotto Bites with Roasted Garlic Herb Aioli and Marinara, as well as the Charcuterie and Cheese Board featuring Gorgonzola Blue Cheese, Fontina, Prosciutto Di Parma, Spanish-style Chorizo, Green Olives, Marinated Mushrooms, Walnuts, and Dry-

cured Black Beldi Olives. Naturally, it was a lot of food, but I was here for the tasting, not the gorging, dear readers. I paired the meal with a featured flight of wines, and I began to consume.

Painstakingly careful to prevent the food from influencing the true flavors of the wines, I found myself softening somewhat as I tasted. The wines were multifaceted and thoughtfully selected. The food was like an old friend who knew when to bark and when to bite. A perfectly complimentary companion, and an adventure in every bite. I could no longer fight the fight. My sardonic taste buds gave in, and I began, dare I say, to enjoy myself. I heard the music. Admired the playful couples, families, and friends throughout. And even began to mingle.

And that's when I realized, that was precisely the goal of this establishment. To create a place where people would

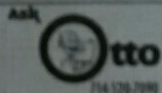

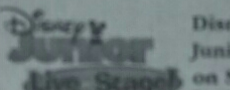

Disney's Aladdin - A Musical Spectacular

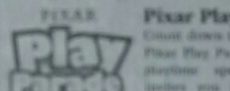
