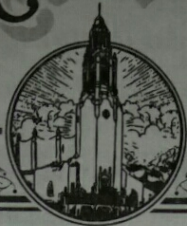

Storytellers Statue A Suitcase and a Dream

A bold beginning captured. Walt Disney and Mickey Mouse are honored with a distinguished bronze statue on Buena Vista Street. The statue immortalizes the great partnership between the pair. Together, Walt a fledgling film maker and his most famous creation, Mickey embarked on a new, wonderful adventure. Uncertain about their prospects, but with a suitcase filled with hope and promise for the future.

At the base of the statue, aptly named "Storytellers" is a plaque that retells Walt's story in his own words. "It was July 1923. I packed all of my worldly goods - a pair of trousers, a checkered coat, a lot of drawing materials and the last of the fairy tale reels we had made - in a kind of frayed cardboard suitcase. And with that wonderful audacity of youth, I went to Hollywood, arriving there with just forty dollars. It was a big day the day I got on the Santa Fe California Limited. I was just free and happy!" - Walt Disney

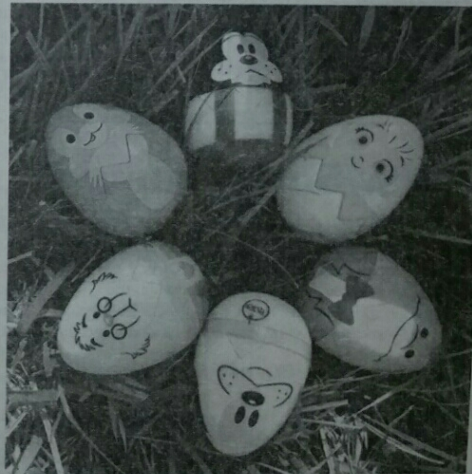
EGGS-TRA, EGGS-TRA Egg-Stravaganza Returns

As always, we started our day by grabbing our map, Entertainment Guide and Buena Vista Bugle and spread them out at the Fiddler, Fifer & Practical Cafe so we could plan out our day with our two young friends. It quickly became evident that Gayle and I had very different days ahead of us. Aidan's selections were fast, competitive and wet. Ariel's were all about spending time with the princesses. Their itineraries below:

Itinerary for Aidan the Adventurer

- 1) Strategize on ways to score more points than your partner at Toy Story Midway Mania.

Per Aidan's request, we made our way to the front of the viewing area, and Gayle could be heard saying, "Great, we are in the spray area, just what I need, MORE water". She was still soggy after riding Grizzly River Run three times.

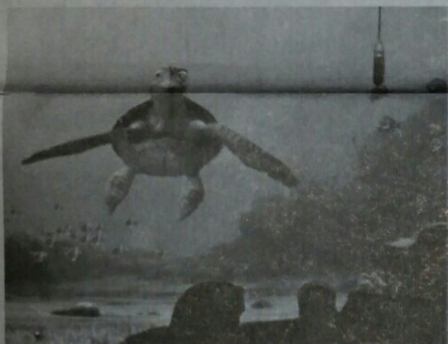

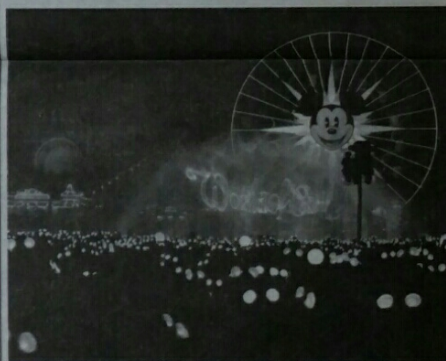
Here's a preview of what's coming to Disney California Adventure Park when the Disneyland® Resort Diamond Celebration begins.

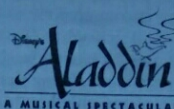
