Mediterranean Fare at Paradise Garden Grill

It's not often that I venture outdoors during this season, as temperatures rise and humanity fills the streets. I prefer to remain indoors, respectfully unwilted, un-ruffled and uninterrupted by crowds. So imagine the depths of my delight when my lovely editor suggested I break from my peaceful solitude and venture across town to write about the fare at Paradise Garden Grill. I thought of declining the request momentarily but the emptiness of my fine leather billfold goaded me on. So, armed with my writer's pad and pen of sardonicism, I was off to another epicurean adventure.

I made a surprisingly short journey to the Paradise Garden Grill and was welcomed by cypress trees shading a quaint piazza and live musicians playing at the Paradise Garden Bandstand. Families were gathered enjoying the food, music and the shade of the piazza. I found myself charmed by the atmosphere. But it was the food that I was there for, and I would not be seduced by mere aesthetics.

I perused the menu which specialized in Mediterranean skewered meats and vegetables. I took note of the vegetable and tofu skewer and the beef gyro platter but decided to partake in a perfectly grilled and seasoned Lemon-Oregano Chicken Skewer served with Rice Pilaf, a refreshing cucumber


Inglebert also recommends:




Adventure Awaits Grizzly Peak


